Pastor Andrew's Message

After Her late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II passed away, books of condolence were opened in many places across the UK. We also see books of remembrance at cemeteries and crematoriums sometimes. But did you know that God keeps books of remembrance? In the message today we will hopefully see what they contain and how this affects all of us. We will look at the imperial throne, the impartial judge, the incriminating records, and the irrevocable sentence. Is your name written in the Book of Life? We will also see that the fact of a coming final judgement where wrongs will be righted can be a comfort to those us us who have experienced injustices in this life: as Dr M L King said 'the ark of the moral universe is long, but it bends towards justice'.
