Pastor Andrew's Message

Today we are looking at a short passage from the time of Elisha the prophet containing a miracle of the raising of an axe head from water. In the passage, Elisha, represents Jesus, the sons of the prophets Christians, especially Christian workers, and the axe head represents the anointing or enabling we are given by the Holy Spirit to serve God and get the job done. Have you lost your cutting edge spiritually? I believe this passage shows us the steps we need to take to recover our cutting edge, and we will look at these steps this morning. As Zechariah 4:6 says, 'Not by might, not by power, but by my Spirit, says the Lord'.
