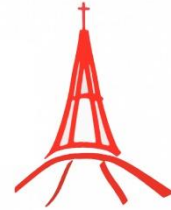

Pastor Andrew's Message

This is the final message on the book of the prophet Jonah. It is a book that is very relevant for us, despite it being 2800 years old. It applies to us in a number of ways, but as I have said, especially in the areas of prayer and evangelism. The truth is that at various times in our lives, you and me can be like Jonah, for example we can be frustrated and angry about our changing circumstances and fail to see God's heart. What is your Nineveh, the thing that God wants you to do that you don't want to do? Our merciful God delivers us even when we resist his guidance in our lives, and gives us a second chance. As our sister Regina said a couple of weeks ago, there is no fifth chapter of Jonah- the fifth chapter is probably US. How will we respond?
