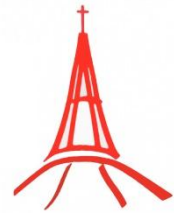

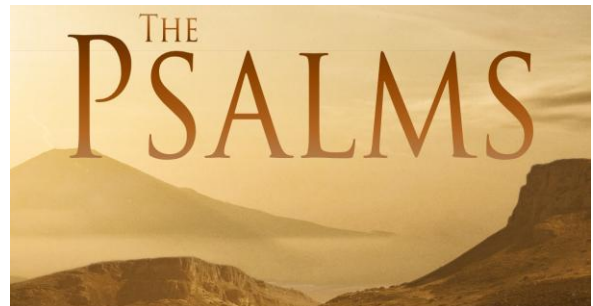

Pastor Andrew's Message

Today we continue our series on the psalms called 'Unpacking the depths of faith' with a look at Psalm 32. This is what is classified as a 'penitential' psalm, and it is about David's experience of confession of sin and forgiveness of sins. The title today is 'A great man's testimony' and we will see a great beatitude (v1-2), a great testimony (v3-5) a great recommendation (v6-7) and a great promise (v8-10). D L Moody, the great 19th century evangelist, said 'there is no true prayer without confession. As long as we have unconfessed sin in our soul, we are not going to have power with God in prayer.'



As it is the third Sunday in the month we will have an **offering during Communion**. Pastor Andrew administers this fund to help anyone in the fellowship who may be in need.
