### Pastor Andrew's Message

Advent is the season when the Christian church looks forward to the coming of Jesus at Bethlehem and at end of age to reign as King. So, this morning in our Psalms series I have chosen for us to look at Psalm 2, which is a royal or kingship psalm. The message is entitled 'The King is coming'. These types of Psalms were used in major ceremonies like coronations. Psalm 2 is like a great 4 act drama: we see Act 1: Satan's agenda (v1-3), Act 2: God's agenda (v4-6), Acts 3: The Son claims His inheritance (v7-9) and Act 4: The author sounds a warning (v10-12). Is Jesus king of your life?
