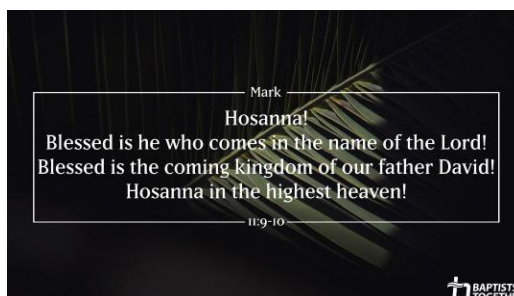

Pastor Andrew's Message

Today is Palm Sunday, when the church remembers Jesus triumphal entry into Jerusalem in the week before his death and resurrection. There, the crowds shouted the words of Psalm 118:25-26, so I thought that would be a good Psalm for us to look at as this morning as we continue the Psalms series. It is actually the middle chapter of the whole Bible, before it comes the shortest chapter (Psalm 117) and after it comes the longest chapter (Psalm 119). It teaches us that God's love is the foundation of our thanksgiving (v1-4), in times of trouble God is our deliverer (v5-14), Jesus is the cornerstone of God's plan (v22-24) and our response to God's love should be worship and obedience (v28-29).
