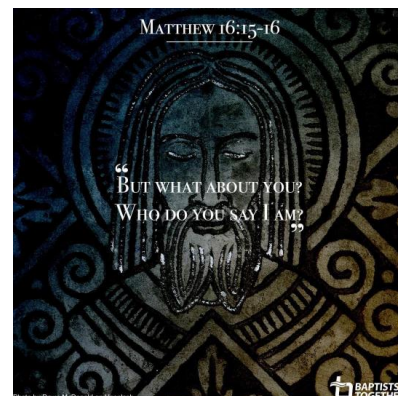
Benediction
