Pastor Andrew's Message

This morning's message is part 2 of 'Jesus model of evangelism', using Matthew 4:19 as a basis, the famous 'fishers of men' passage. We are looking at various principles based on what Jesus did, and last time we spoke of 1. Know what you are fishing for 2. Learn to think like a fish 3. Focus on fish that are hungry. Today we will also look at 4. Use different bait to catch different fish 5. Use more hooks to catch more fish and 6. Fish for the kind of fish your church relates to. One question we are also covering today is 'How do we know when the fish are hungry?' In other words how do we know when people are spiritually receptive? The parable of the soils (sometimes known as parable of the sower) gives us help in understanding this.
