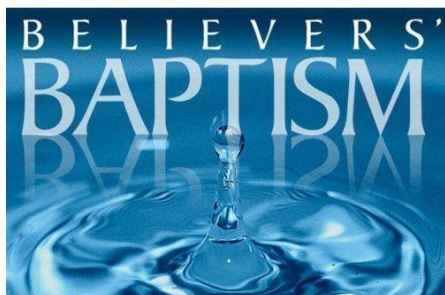

Pastor Andrew's Message

The title of my message today is 'How to make God smile'. We are going to be looking briefly at the example of Noah, of whom it was said 'Noah was a pleasure to the Lord' (Genesis 6:8 Living Bible). We will see that God smiles when we love Him supremely, when we trust Him completely, when we obey Him wholeheartedly, when we praise and thank Him continually, and when we serve Him by using our abilities. Psalm 14:2 in the Living Bible says 'God looks down from heaven on all mankind to see if there are any who are wise, who want to please God'. Will you make pleasing God the goal of your life, or will you (in the words of the Fleetwood Mac song) 'go your own way'?
