Prayer If you would like someone to pray with you in confidence, please come to the front left of the church after the service.

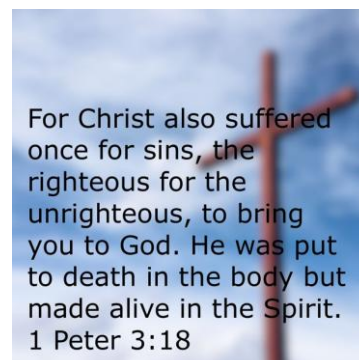

Pastor Andrew's Message

This morning we are looking at just one verse, 1 Peter 3:18, which is one of a few verses in the Bible which give a clear, simple, and concise summary of the cross of Jesus and the gospel and what it means for us. Do you know what was going on when Jesus died on the cross? Are you clear about what the good news is? And more importantly, have you responded to it personally? This morning we will see that: 1. Jesus died to pay the penalty 2. Jesus died in your place. 3. Jesus died to make a relationship with God possible for you and 4. Jesus rising again is proof of this.
